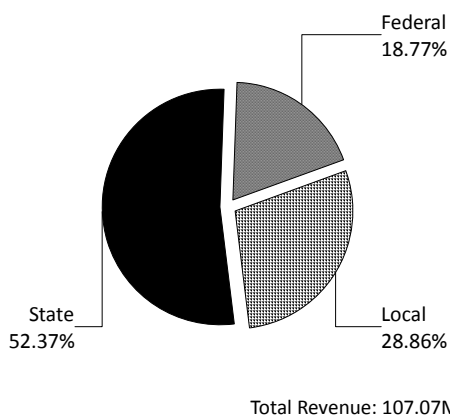

Revenue Sources



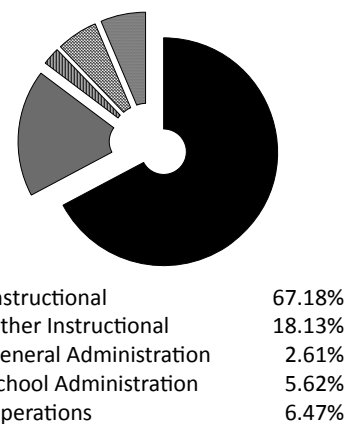
