Drivers will sanitize the bus at the conclusion of all bus routes.

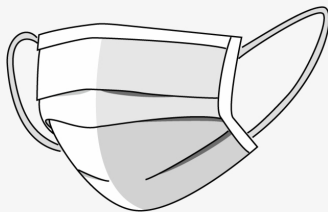
Students and bus drivers can wear masks or face coverings that follow dress code while inside the bus.



All cafeterias will be open and fully functional.

Covered or individually wrapped food items will be offered when feasible.

Sneeze guards and touchless hand sanitization stations at each serving line.



Masks and face shields will be optional. If mandated by the governor, faculty, staff, and students will be required to wear them. Masks and face shields must meet dress code requirements.



Harrison County School District will follow all Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) guidelines as it pertains to athletic events and activities. Per MHSAA, virtual learning students may not participate in athletics or activities.



### Other Information

- School visitors may be limited per recommendations of the MS Department of Health
- Touchless hand sanitizers will be placed at all school entrances. Hand sanitizer will be in all rooms.
- The additional custodial staff hired for the 20-21 school year will be retained to assist with cleaning and sanitizing school facilities as often as possible.
