

Computer Assisted Instruction

Students in grades kindergarten through eight receive thirty minutes of computer-assisted instruction daily in reading and mathematics provided through the Curriculum Computer Corporation software. Students in grades seven through nine have access to compensatory, on-line assistance in every subject area through Nova Net. Nova Net also provides credit recovery for students in grades nine through twelve. Accelerated Reader is in place in every school serving kindergarten through eight. Other targeted software programs as Boxer Algebra and Thinking Maps are in use within the District.
