The Lead Teacher Program in the Harrison County School District began in 1996. Lead Teachers are a team of highly qualified teachers who serve as mentors to classroom teachers, as instructional assistants to the principal, and as school level coordinators for the District's Department of Curriculum and Instruction. Lead Teachers serve on curriculum teams; student achievement teams, behavioral support teams, and act as technology assistants at their respective schools. They create and provide professional development addressing best practices at the school level. The Lead Teacher is an integral component to the successful implementation of curriculum and instruction at schools serving any of grades Kindergarten through eight.
